STVP provides entrepreneurship education through fellowships, courses, and online resources to help you build your entrepreneurial mindset.

Accel Leadership Program

A six-month program that prepares 24 technically-minded juniors, seniors, and graduate students to lead entrepreneurial ventures through workshops, team-based case study projects, and real-world business problem-solving.
