1	Anger	<IN AN ANGRY VOICE - ALMOST YELLING> What did you just tell Charlie about me?
2	Anger	<IN AN ANGRY VOICE> Yesterday, my sister visited me at work. [DISGUSTED UGH]
3	Questioning	<1st SENTENCE IS A STATEMENT, 2nd IS QUESTION> Yesterday, I met Bob. Your sister likes him?
4	Sarcastic	<IMPLY: YOU DON'T BELIEVE IT> My coworkers [LIGHT SCOFF] forgot to invite me.
5	Neutral	<IMPLY: YOU DON'T BELIEVE IT> My sister said she ordered coffee, but the waiter brought tea.
6	Humorous	<WITH HILARITY> [LAUGH] Oh... my... god... , that is so funny!
7	Happy, Sad	<START MILDLY HAPPY> It's happy in one respect, [SIGH] <CHANGE TO SAD> and sad in another.
8	Thoughtful	<IN A THOUGHTFUL VOICE> Well, [LONG CONTEMPLATIVE HMM] I'm not really sure about that.
9	Sad	<IN A LAMENTING VOICE> I just [QUIET MOMENT] miss him... so... much.
